BY THE NUMBERS

- 240+ events; 9,000 people reached
- 5,000+ signups to DistrictBuilder mapping tool; 8,200 maps started
- Three contests, 1,010 entries, \$103k in prizes awarded
- 103 secondary schools, 48 colleges involved
- 30 state lawmakers have met with DTL mappers
- 90 pieces of state and national media coverage

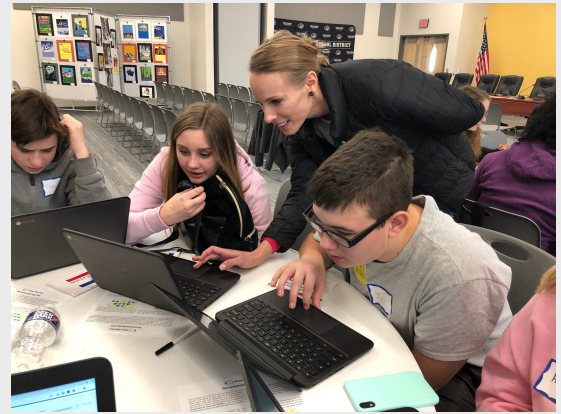

IMPACT

60% of participants say DTL gave them confidence they could act to end gerrymandering.*

97% said they engaged with the redistricting issue after being exposed to DTL; 45% took at least three steps to engage; 23% contacted a lawmaker.*

Participants reported DTL increased likelihood they would take part in other civic advocacy.*

Gov. Wolf named David Thornburgh, CEO of our parent organization, as chair of the bipartisan PA Redistricting Reform Commission, showing DTL's reputation for engagement on this issue.

DTL received national recognition in the fall of 2019: as a featured organization in the annual publication of the Center for High Impact Philanthropy, and a national finalist for the Civvy's Award.
